Project for promoting medical collaboration in China

- The probability of dying between exact ages 30 and 70 from non-communicable diseases (NCDs) of cardiovascular diseases, cancer, diabetes, and chronic respiratory diseases, an indicator related to Target 3.4 of the SDGs, was 15.9% in China, and 8.3% in Japan, as of 2019(World Health Statistics 2021).
- Seminars of NCD control, mainly cancer and diabetes, will be held online to introduce Japanese medical technology and medical care for current lifestyle-related diseases to medical professionals at Tsinghua University, Peking University, and related medical institutions with which NCGM has concluded MOUs.
- Through the seminars of NCD control, this project will promote collaboration among medical institutions in China.
