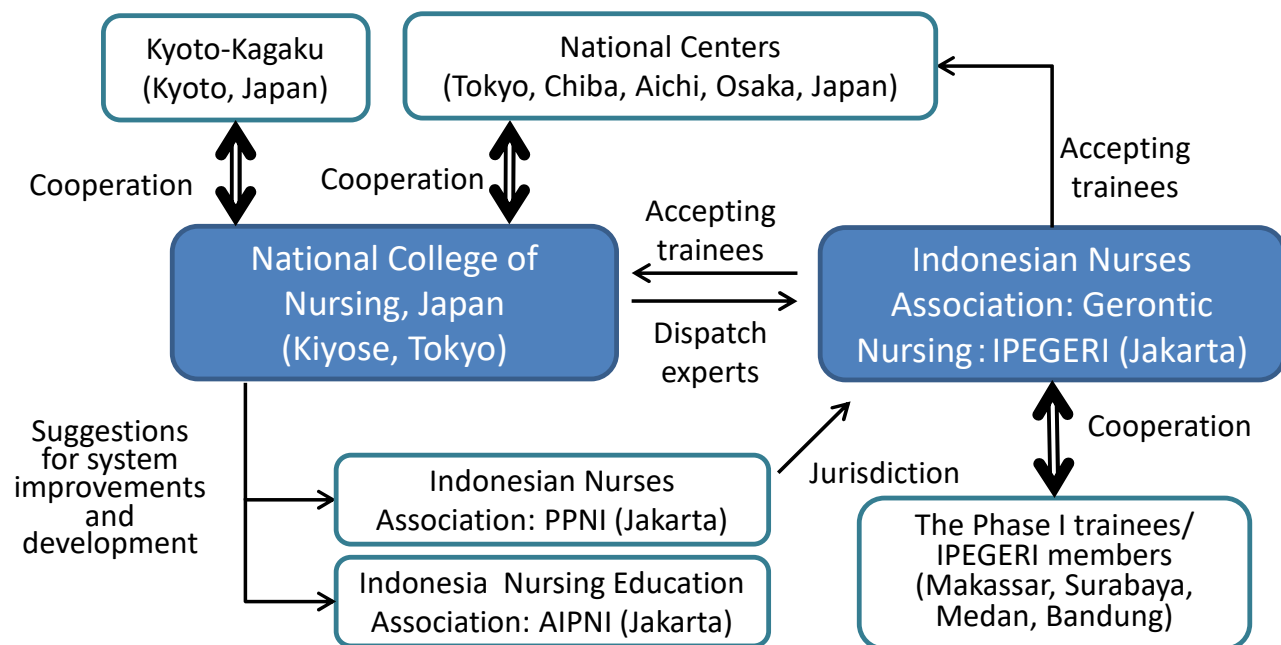


## A project to enhance the teaching skills in gerontic nursing of Indonesian clinical nurse preceptors

- 1. Background:** Gerontic nursing education has only just begun in Indonesia due to a huge demand for elderly care.
- 2. Objective:** To improve the teaching skills of clinical preceptors in Indonesia.
- 3. Overview:** The National College of Nursing Japan (NCNJ) that employs the unification of clinical settings and academia conducts training seminars with the Indonesian Nurses Association Gerontic Nursing Section (IPEGGERI) for the trainees who had participated in the previous phase 2020-22. The contents of the training seminars include learning about the elderly care, the designated training course concept for clinical nurse preceptors in Japan, and the development of nursing practice materials and teaching plans using digital devices on dementia, delirium, and feeding/swallowing functions, etc.
- 4. Outcomes and effects:** To develop nursing practice materials and teaching plans while utilizing the trainees' knowledge gained in the previous phase 2020-22 as well as their understanding during the current phase (knowledge about the elderly care and the concept of the training course for clinical preceptors in Japan).



### <Training Schedule>

#### May-August Online training (10 trainees):

- Lectures on training guidance (unification of clinical practice and education, overview of the concept of the training course for clinical preceptors in Japan)

#### August: Experts dispatched (2 persons)

- Technical guidance on developing practice materials and teaching plans; Check understanding of the concept of the training course for clinical preceptors.

#### October: Training in Japan (10 participants)

- Technical guidance on elderly care in Japan
- Technical guidance on conducting the training course for clinical preceptors.

#### January: Dispatch of experts (2 persons)

- Technical guidance on preparation of clinical practice training materials.
