
Project for promoting medical collaboration to China

- The probability of dying between exact ages 30 and 70 from non-communicable diseases (NCDs), an indicator related to Target 3.4 of the SDGs, was 15.9% in China, and 8.3% in Japan, as of 2019(World Health Statistics).
- As China's population ages, the number of elderly paraplegics is estimated to increase from 41 million in 2020 to more than 64 million by 2040.
- Online seminars will be held for medical professionals at Tsinghua University, Peking University with which NCGM has MOUs, and other local medical institutions such as Huaibei People's Hospital and the general public to provide medical technology and medical care at the Center hospital of the NCGM.
- By introducing the products of Japanese companies related to each seminar, we will promote sales of Japanese medical technology and medical-related products.
