
Project to Strengthen Mammography in the Arab Republic of Egypt and the Arab Republic of Kenya

- 1. In the Arab Republic of Egypt, a campaign is underway to promote breast cancer screening, but there is a shortage of technologist and high demand for technical assistance.
- 2. In Kenya, 6,799 new cases of breast cancer a year (2020) are diagnosed including a young age female, with more being diagnosed at stage III or IV.
- 3.NCGM plans to provide technical assistance in mammography to Cairo University Hospital, MOH and AIC Kijabe Hospital in order to homogenize the technical level of mammography throughout Egypt or Kenya.
- 4. NCGM radiologists will train mammography in Japan for Cairo University Hospital, etc. and perform technical training to other medical institutions in Egypt together with the technologists trained in Japan.
- 5. In 2023, the mammography skills will be improved at Cairo University Hospital, etc. and after the completion of this project, the training will be continued in Egypt, mainly at Cairo University Hospital, etc..
