

Project to improve the quality and safety of medical care in Vietnam

- In Vietnam, the medical safety management system in hospitals has been established by the Ministry of Health. However, there are still issues regarding implementing patient safety activity in clinical fields in each hospital. In order to solve the issues, the Ministry of Health and key hospitals (former trainees of the previous projects) requested technical support.
- The National Center for Global Health and Medicine (NCGM) in collaboration with the Ministry of Health of Vietnam will implement three activities as follows;
 - ① Providing technical support (including online training) and monitoring for major hospitals;
 - ② Development of training tools to be used sustainably in in-hospital training at target medical institutions
 - ③ knowledge sharing forum on Patient Safety and Quality Improvement.
- Throughout this fiscal year, effective improvement processes for promoting medical safety will be identified through ① and ②, then outcomes and good practices will be shared widely through ③.

< Schedule >

- Major hospitals are to be nominated. (From April to May, 202)
- Onsite and Online training and monitoring (From May to Dec, 2023)
