A project to enhance the teaching skills of Indonesian nurse preceptors in gerontic nursing

- 1. Background: A systematic gerontic nursing education and training has begun in Indonesia due to a huge demand for elderly care.
- 2. Objective: To improve the teaching skills of nurse preceptors in Indonesia, focusing on gerontic nursing area.
- **3. Overview:** The National College of Nursing Japan (NCNJ) employs the unification of clinical settings and academia, and conducts training seminars for the clinical nurse preceptors. The NCNJ support the Indonesian National Nurses Association (INNA) and gerontic nursing division (IPEGERI) to develop and conduct nurse preceptor training in gerontic nursing, which is approved by the Ministry of Health Indonesia.
- 4. Outcomes and effects: By establishing a training system for nurse preceptors with knowledge and skills in gerontic nursing, the training has become established throughout Indonesia, and has improved nurse preceptors' teaching skills of geriatric nursing in basic nursing education.
