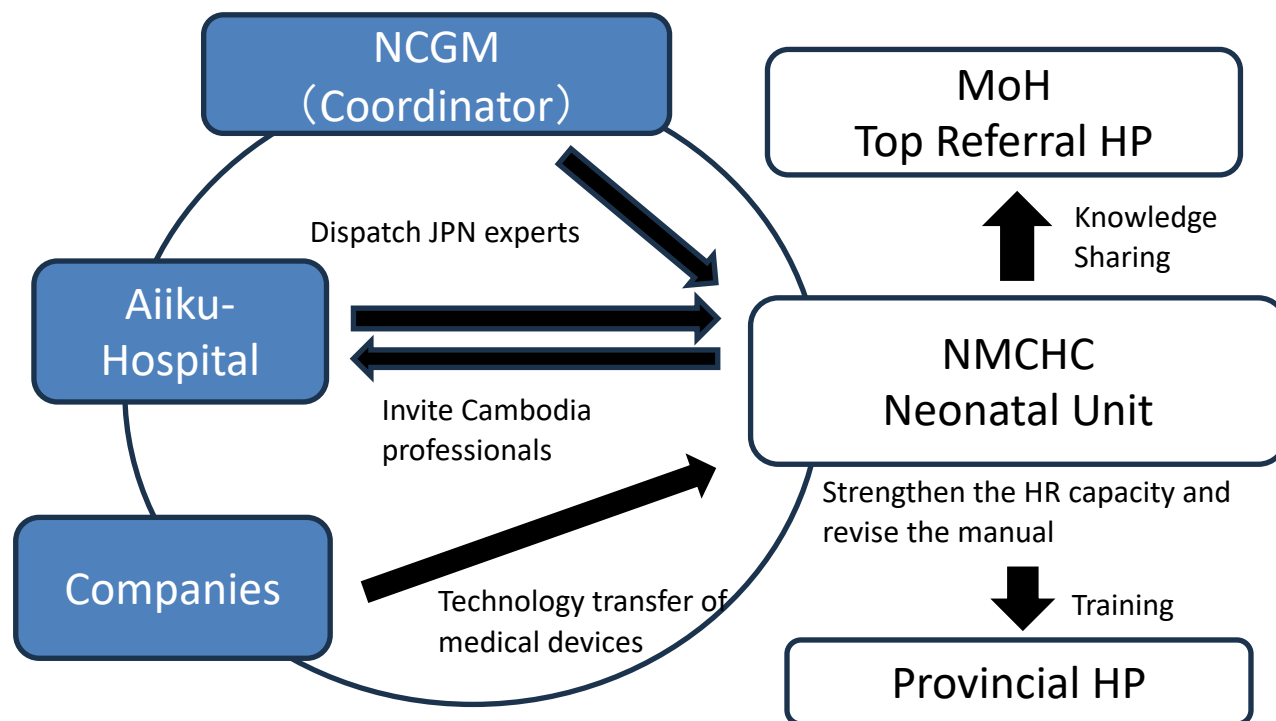


Human Resource Development Project for Neonatal Care Services in Cambodia

1. In Cambodia, the neonatal mortality rate has been improving. However, to further improve the neonatal mortality rate, it is necessary to improve the quality of medical care, including **advanced intensive care**.
2. **NCGM has signed an MOU with NMCHC** and has provided long-term support for development of neonatal care manuals for nurses and doctors.
3. In recent years, **NMCHC has become more independent**, and there is momentum to increase revenues and expand medical services for maternal and child health.
4. NMCHC is in a position to provide guidance to subordinate hospitals as an administrative function, and the scope of this project will also include **the expansion of the improved neonatal medical services to the lower level**.



<Expected Outcomes>

- Improving the quality of neonatal services at NMCHC
- Reduction of neonatal deaths at NMCHC
- Development of neonatal care manuals
- Guidance to provincial hospitals by NMCHC
- Improved utilization of neonatal medical products

- AUG: Cambodian staffs visit JPN for training
- OCT to DEC: JPN experts visit Cambodia for training and revision of neonatal care manual
