Perioperative cooperation/support for thoracic surgery for major hospitals in Vietnam based on collaboration between the Japan-Vietnam Society of Thoracic Surgery

- The strong need to learn surgery and perioperative treatment from Japan, and many requests for technological development from big hospitals, including the government.
- To make the protocol for postoperative lung cancer between NCGM and 108, 175 military hospitals
- NCGM/JACS aims to improve the level of surgical care in Vietnam, including perioperative management, surgical guidance, and postoperative management to the big central Hospital.
- By providing technical support to the central hospital, medical technology will be transmitted to the lower hospitals, so it is expected that the medical level of the whole country will rise by improving the surgical operation and perioperative management in Vietnam.
