## Enhancement of clinical techniques and qualification development for Cybernics therapy towards other APAC countries by Master Trainers based in Malaysia

- In Southeast Asian countries, personalized rehabilitation is conducted by a limited number of physical therapists. On the other hand, in various Asian countries, rapid aging is expected to progress, and efficient rehabilitation is anticipated. In Thailand, it is expected that the aging rate will exceed 30% by 2030, and even the team at the Thai Prime Minister's Office is aware of this issue.
- 2 Training is conducted for healthcare professionals in Thailand, Indonesia, and other APAC countries with the aim of promoting the spread of HAL
- Tsukuba University, Fukuoka University, Kyoto University, and Fujita Health University, which have extensive experience with HAL therapy, collaborate with the Physical Therapists Association to conduct training at major hospitals in Thailand and Indonesia.
- 4 Through this training, HAL master trainers will be developed within major hospitals in Thailand and Indonesia by the end of 2024. Through the trained master trainers, the aim is to establish the spread and effective treatment of HAL in each country
