

## Project to develop Surgical Oncologists for Gastrointestinal Cancer in Myanmar

- In Myanmar, the ratio of the digestive cancer in the cause of death is increasing, however, a doctor who can provide rapid and exact diagnosis, or safe and less-invasive treatment is still few.
- The procedure of endoscopy or laparoscopic surgery in Japan is superior to Myanmar, Kanagawa Cancer Center will dispatch some specialists aiming at the technology transfer for the diagnosis and treatment of cancer in cooperation with a New Yangon General Hospital.
- ●In this project, the training of surgical oncologist who will be a leading specialist in Myanmar, the spread of the endoscopic and surgical technology, and the improvement of the mortality are expected.
