● Background

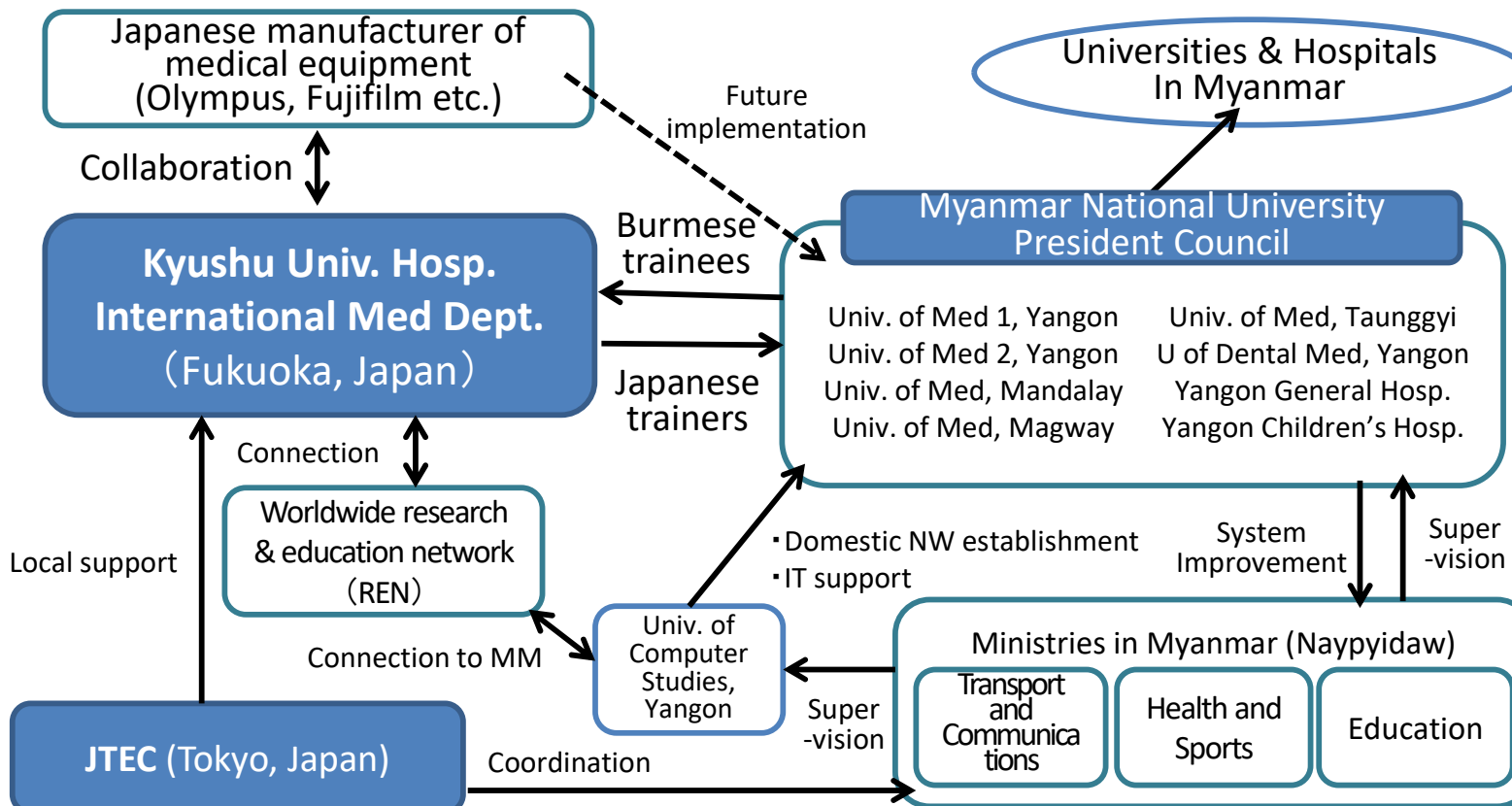
In Myanmar, there are variety of problems unsolved in health care, such as medical disparities in urban and rural areas, specialists shortage, and lack of post-graduate medical education system.
