

Orthopedics specialists training in Myanmar

- In Myanmar, in general orthopedics and spinal surgery, human resource development is in progress, and although there is a shortage in the number of individuals, the level of individual skills is increasing. On the other hand, in other fields (artificial joint surgery, bone and soft part tumor surgery, etc.), there are very few specialists, and human resource development is delayed.
- At the request of Yangon First Medical University, specialists are dispatched to Yangon Orthopedic Hospital and Mandalay Orthopedic Hospital for the two fields of joint surgery and bone and soft tissue tumor and trauma, and trainees are accepted. The project-based hospital has a wealth of experience, and has exchanges with the above-mentioned hospitals, enabling smooth implementation and continuous follow-up of the project.
- In this project, we aim to acquire advanced treatments in this special field through dispatching experts and accepting trainees. After the project implementation, the practice of the technology advances in clinical practice, and contributing to the sustainable and autonomous development of medical care that leads to human resource development is the ultimate goal of the project.
