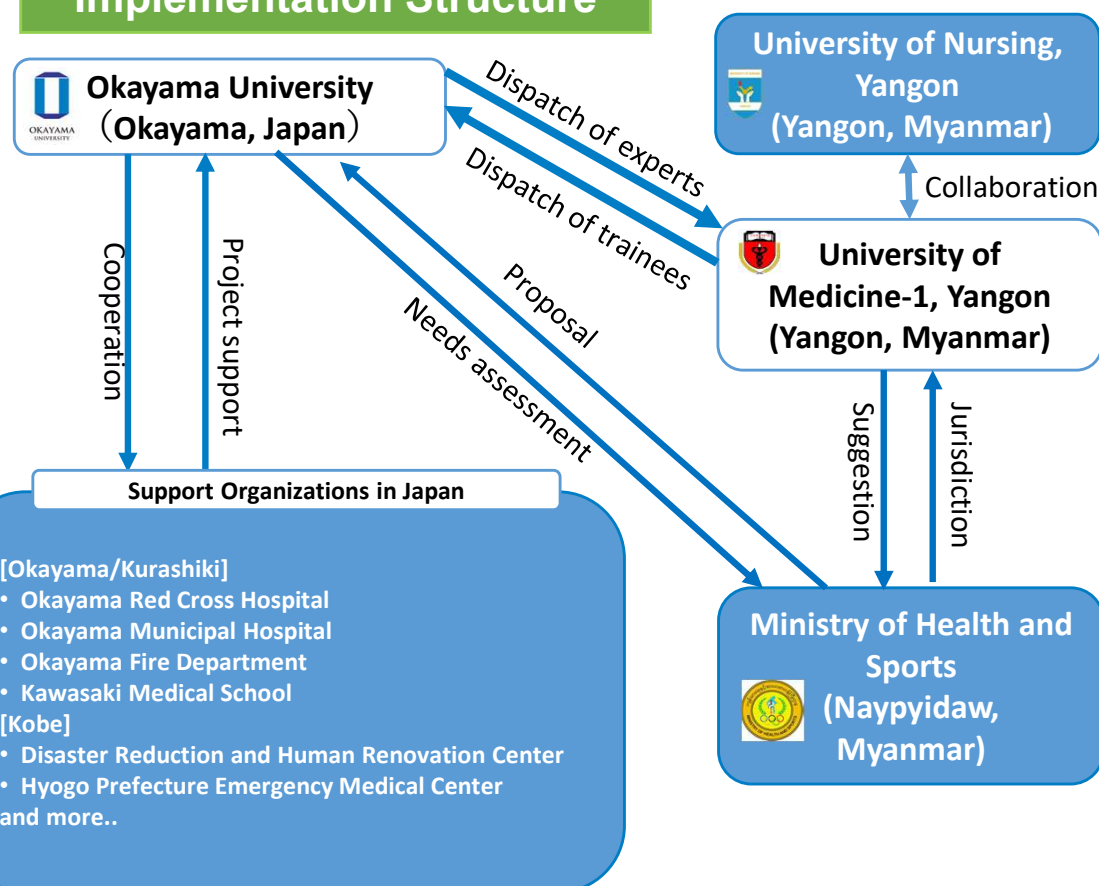


# Project for Development of Human Resource of Emergency and Disaster Medicine/DHED

- Myanmar is prone to natural disasters. Yet, the country has been vulnerable to those disasters due to lack of infrastructure and human resources in health sector especially in emergency and disaster medicine, which could threaten the well-being of people in Myanmar.
- This project will support development of human resources (**doctors and nurses**) in disaster medicine and strengthening the disaster medical system in Myanmar by utilizing the knowledge and methods learned from Japan's experiences in large-scale disasters.
- By targeting faculty members, this project will contribute to establish a sustainable education system of disaster medicine and further to expand emergency and disaster medical system in Myanmar.
