International Collaboration on Huma Resource Development in Pediatric Acute Medicine in Mongolia

- There is an improvement in neonatal and child mortality in Mongolia, however, they still remain high. Cause of deaths in children include neonatal disease and respiratory infection (pneumonia). These are related to Neonatology and Pediatric Emergency and Critical Care Medicine.
- In order to improve the quality and human resourse development in Neonatal ICU (NICU), Pediatric ICU (PICU) and Emergency Department (ED), collaborative work between National Center for Child Health and Development (NCCHD), Japan and National Center for Maternal and Child Health (NCMCH), Mongolia will be carried out.
- Mongolian physicians and nurses will take observership at NCCHD. NCCHD experts in each area will visit Mongolia for providing education and training. Mongolian staff will develop their own education material in these fields. They may contribute to the health policy making in Mongolia
